## RULES OF PLAY:

### OPEN PLAY

- Groups can hold a court for an hour after another group shows up and is waiting.
- The group on the court the longest should volunteer to come off the court and allow the others to play.
- If both parties agree, other arrangements can be made ie. one game on, one game off.
- Be considerate, if you have already played for more than an hour, consider your playing limit 2 hours.

### ROTATIONAL PLAY

- All games will be to 11 win by 2; After your game incorporate the waiting players into play.
- If 4 or more players are waiting all 4 players who finished come off court, and the next 4 players in line take the court.
- When all 4 courts are in use, those waiting to play should place their paddles in the paddle rack to designate next up.
- The overflow courts may be used for Rotational Play (if not in use for tennis), however, players do have the option to wait for the dedicated courts if desired. Others that are willing to play on the overflow courts will jump them in line.
- If 2 or more players want to come on together, they stack their paddles together and wait their turn for next up.

### CHALLENGE COURT PLAY

- Courts 1 & 2 are for "Intermediate Play" (3.0-3.5), courts 4 & 5 are for "Advanced Play" (4.0+), Courts 5-8 are for overflow play.
- All Games are to 11, win by 2.
- After your game, the winning team stays & plays the first 2 new players in line, switching partners is optional.
- Winners stay on as long as they keep winning with a 3 game limit.

- Open to the public.
